

Policy

The Board of Governors shall watch over and guide the interests of the school, ensuring the implementation of the Statutes of Stichting AFNORTH International School.

Procedures

1. The Board of Governors will meet a minimum of twice per year, once in the autumn and again in the spring. Extra-ordinary meetings may be held at the call of the Chair.
2. The spring meeting will deal with the establishment of the international budget and related business matters.
3. The autumn meeting will feature educational topics pertinent to the school in addition to business matters.
4. The Chair of The Board of Governors along with the Director prepares the agenda for Board of Governors' meeting.
5. For the Board of Governors Meeting shall be invited:
 - a. One authorized representative to the Board of Governors from each of the contracting parties (Canada, Germany, United Kingdom, and United States of America).
 - b. An additional representative of The Netherlands government in an advisory non-voting capacity.
 - c. An additional representative of the Commander in Chief of the NATO base in Brunssum in an advisory non-voting capacity.
 - d. The Director of the School in an advisory non-voting capacity.
 - e. The Assistant Director of the School in an advisory non-voting capacity.
 - f. The Chair of the Financial Advisory Board in an advisory non-voting capacity.
 - g. The Finance Manager of the School in an advisory non-voting capacity.
 - h. Additional guests invited by the Chair of Board in an advisory non-voting capacity.
