National Section Heads Procedures

Policy

The National Section Heads and if applicable the Administrators will co-ordinate the educational programs, curricula and accreditation requirements of their National Sections.

Definitions

National Section Heads:

People appointed by the member nations (Canada, The Federal Republic of Germany, United Kingdom, United States of America) as principals or Head Teachers to lead their school section. Administrators:

People appointed by the member nations (Canada, The Federal Republic of Germany, United Kingdom, United States of America) as principals or Head Teachers to lead their administrative sector.

Procedures

- 1. The National Section Heads and Administrators will meet regularly to co-ordinate the program.
- 2. The National Section Heads and Administrators, the Director and the Assistant Director will meet as the Management Team in order to address international requirements. As required, the Management Team will be assisted by the Assistant National Section Heads and the Business Department. In case of voting each National Section will have one vote.
- 3. The National Section Heads and Administrators, supported by other school leaders will coordinate the program offerings at the school.
- 4. The National Section Heads and Administrators will meet on a regular basis with their respective parent councils.
