

**Rationale**

The community shares responsibility with the Board of Governors of Stichting AFNORTH International School for the provision of an education for students attending the school. International Advisory Board members support the school in this endeavour.

**Policy**

Stichting AFNORTH International School shall have an International Advisory Board which meets at regular intervals, supports the Director, gives advice, and hears reports on current affairs of the school.

**Guidelines**

1. The International Advisory Board shall be composed of:
  - 1.1 The School Director as Chair.
  - 1.2 One representative of the parents of the children of each of the contracting parties.
  - 1.3 The Chair from each of the national section's advisory council.
  - 1.4 A senior national military representative from each of the contracting nations.
  - 1.5 The Heads of the four National Sections.
  - 1.6 A representative of the Commander of the NATO Headquarters in Brunssum.
  - 1.7 A representative of the Financial Controller of the NATO base in Brunssum.
  - 1.8 One representative from the International Staff Council
  - 1.9 The School liaison officers from the contracting nations
  - 1.10 Additional non-voting members may be invited to the Advisory Board.
  
2. For items requiring a decision of the advisory board, a simple majority shall be sufficient for the decisions of the International Advisory Board.

**Review**

This policy will be reviewed in accordance with Policy 1020 Policy Development and Review.
