

Rationale

Stichting AFNORTH International School Brunssum provides an education which follows the curriculum and is accredited by each of the owning nations. This curriculum at the international level provides programs that promote internationalism.

Policy

Stichting AFNORTH International School shall make particular efforts to promote internationalism.

Guidelines

1. A partner language program funded by the directorate budget shall offer German to English speaking children and English to German speaking children. At the discretion of the Canadian Section Head, Canadian French language programs may be made available to non-Canadians wishing French language instruction.
2. The directorate shall offer a “learn to swim” program.
3. The directorate budget shall support opportunities for secondary school students to take part in governmental simulation programs which aim at developing democratic involvement in government activities which promote internationalism such as: Model European Parliament; Model United Nations, Harvard Model Congress Europe, Model NATO.
4. The directorate shall encourage and participate in funding international cultural undertakings or study trips that are related to the curriculum.
5. The directorate shall provide a range of international awards for presentation each year to encourage those who get involved internationally and meet the established criteria for such awards.

Review
