Student Exchange Policy**4080**

Rationale

Student exchanges enable students the greatest possible experience in another culture/language.

Policy

It is the policy of Stichting AFNORTH International School Brunssum to accept, in the spirit of its international nature, genuine student exchanges.

Definitions

Student exchange – a program where one or more students attends a different school on a visiting basis.

Residential exchange – a program which includes the registration of an exchange student on the roll of an owning nation.

Guidelines

- 1 Security regulations shall be followed on all student exchanges.
- 2 National regulations concerning residential exchanges could affect this policy.
- 3 The exchange shall include the principle of reciprocity where a student is sent and a student is hosted, not necessarily at the same time.
- 4 Exchanges could range in duration from one day to one school year.
- 5 For residential student exchanges, the students enter a school system wherein the host family has an entitled status to have a dependant attend
- 6 For residential student exchanges, the sponsor shall have guardianship proof which must be submitted to the school legal advisor, ensuring acceptance of full liability for the student.
- 7 For residential student exchanges the sponsor shall have Dutch Tax Authorities approval.
