
SCHOOL OPERATIONS

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Food Services Policy

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Rationale

The school day includes time for students and staff to have lunch. It is the expectation of the school community that a lunch facility be available.

Policy

It is the policy of Stichting AFNORTH International School Brunssum that a hot meal cafeteria service is provided along with an appropriate eating facility for those who bring their own lunch.

Guidelines

- 1 Hygiene standards shall be maintained in eating areas and shall be in line with host nation food safety standards.
- 2 The youngest students shall eat in their classrooms under the supervision of their teachers or teacher aids. All others shall eat in the cafeteria.
- 3 For health and cleanliness reasons food shall be consumed in the cafeteria except as follows:
 - 3.1 Teachers may take trays of food to the staff lounge or to their classroom. Trays shall be returned to the cafeteria.
 - 3.2 With a teachers' instruction and supervision, in connection with a school activity, students may take trays of food to classroom. Trays shall be returned to the cafeteria.
 - 3.3 During sporting or cultural events in the gyms food may be consumed in the halls. The group organizing the event is responsible to ensure the facility is left as it was found and cleaned of any litter.
 - 3.4 Those who bring food from home are expected to eat in the cafeteria, or in their classroom in the case of the youngest students.
 - 3.5 Staff members shall supervise as needed to ensure the overall objective of keeping our school premises clean and welcoming.

Review
